JERUSALEM / MASADA / JERICHO

We continue to Qumran and the caves where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Stop for lunch and time for those that want to swim in the Dead Sea. Then travel to Jericho, the world's oldest city and walk the dusty streets of the place Jesus called Zacchaeus down from the sycamore tree.



Day 4
JORDAN RIVER / CAPERNAUM


We begin traveling to Yardenit near the Jordan River where you will have a chance to be re-baptized near the same river our Saviour was baptized 2,000 years ago. We will then make our way to a city where Jesus spent much of his time: Capernaum; then on to the Mount of Blessings and also the location where the Multiplication of the fishes took places. Then visit Magdala (the city where Mary was from). We will end our day in a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee (where the words "Peace. Be Still" were once heard).



Day 5

NAZARETH/CAESAREA

This day we have an early morning drive to the city of Nazareth where Christ spent much of his early years. We then proceed to the Valley of Jezreel and on to Megiddo to visit the excavations of over 20 different civilizations. After lunch we will enjoy the epic views over Mount Carmel where Elijah stood against the prophets of Baal. We will end our day by visiting the port city of Caesarea where Paul made that fateful voyage across the frigid waters of the Mediterranean on his way to his martyrdom to Rome.



Day 6
BETHLEHEM

We begin this morning by visiting the Church of the Nativity and then the Shepherds field. We will then visit the famous city of David where we will visit go through Hezekiah's Tunnel and end in the Pool of Siloam where Christ's famous miracle took place. We will then proceed to visit the Tomb of David, The Upper room, Galicanto and the House of Caiphas. After lunch we will then leave early enough to arrive to the Wailing wall before sunset.

This will be a high Sabbath. March 15

Over night flight departing Wednesday, March $15^{th.}$ Arriving Thursday, March 16^{th} in Cairo, Egypt (airport code is CAI. // 7- hour time change forward from EDT)

March 16

Arrive in Cairo. Upon arrival (we will arrive on different flights and slightly different times), we all head directly to our hotel on our own (by taking a taxi or Über or the option of pre-arranged pick up) and get settled. You can choose to relax, or go exploring. In the evening, we will have our first meeting and orientation as a group right after dinner. Then we'll get some rest as a big day awaits us.

March 17

After breakfast, we will enjoy a spectacular trip to Giza to see the amazing Pyramids. We will also visit the great Sphynx, visit the mummified bodies of the Pharaohs of scripture in the NEMC Museum and enjoy a boat tour on the Nile River. Overnight in Cairo.

March 18

Today we will visit the Christian part of all Old Cairo including the Church of Saints Sergius and Bacchus where Jesus lived while in Egypt and then head to the base of Mount Sinai. Cairo. En route, stop by Rafedim, Elim, and Marah (Exodus route). Overnight in St. Catherines.

March 19

On this memorable day, we will wake up early in order to visit Mount Sinai at dawn, the traditional site where it is believed God gave Moses the Ten Commandments. We will have the option to take a camel ride to Elijah's Basin and hike the rest of the way, or walk/hike the entire distance (or stay at the Basin). We will then return to shower, maybe a nap, then tour St. Catherine's Monastery and see the Codex Sinaticus. From there we will head to Nuweiba for the night, and in preparation to cross to the land of Israel. Overnight Nuweiba

March 20

This morning we will head to Taba where we will cross the border into Israel. Then we will proceed to Timna Park located in the heart of the Negev Desert where we will visit a full life size replica of the tabernacle where the children of Israel worshiped. From there we will head to Bethlehem to the place where the story of the anti-type Tabernacle begins: the place where Jesus is born! Overnight Bethlehem.

Post Extension Jordan

March 26 This morning

This morning we will go to the famous Allenby Bridge. We will cross over to Jordan. We will then head to the city of Jerash, one of the cities of the Decapolis and also visit the Jabbok River where Jacob wrestled with the Angel of the Lord.

March 27

This day we head south to the traditional site where John the Baptist baptized Jesus,

where the children of Israel crossed the Jordan River, where Naaman dipped 7 times and where Elijah was taken in a fiery chariot. We then continue to Mt. Nebo, from where God showed Moses the Promised Land; then head to Petra.

March 28

Today we will spend time in one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Start the tour of

Petra; you are in the heart of the rose red Seir mountains as mentioned in the Biblical Book of Genesis. This mountain range houses the Aaron Peak, which is the highest locality in Petra and the burial place of Aaron brother of Moses. A walk down through the narrow 'Siq' passage, being the main entrance to Petra, along 1250 meters brings you to the first monument Treasure "the same as the one seen in the Indiana Jones' movie". We will end our day at Petra and board our bus and drive to our hotel near Amman for Overnight.
