

HOW TO START A A PATHFINDER CLUB

- 1. COUNSEL AND MEET WITH YOUR PASTOR AND CONFERENCE PATHFINDER PERSONEL.**
- 2. PRESENT YOUR PLANS TO THE CHURCH BOARD FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ORGANIZE A PATHFINDER CLUB.**
- 3. AT A SECOND MEETING WITH THE CHURCH BOARD AND CONFERENCE YOUTH MINISTRIES PERSONNEL OR PATHFINDER AREA COORDINATOR, ELECT PATHFINDER DIRECTOR AND DEPUTIES.**
- 4. INFORM CONGREGATION DURING DIVINE SERVICE ABOUT PATHFINDER CLUB, ITS OBJECTIVES AND PROGRAM AND GENERATE CHURCH AND COMMUNITY INTEREST.**
- 5. PATHFINDER OFFICERS ELECT REMAINING EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS.**
- 6. HOLD FIRST MEETING OF PATHFINDER EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO ELECT REMAINING PATHFINDER STAFF.**
- 7. PATHFINDER OFFICERS AND STAFF ATTEND CONFERENCE PATHFINDER BASIC STAFF TRAINING COURSE.**
- 8. CALL PATHFINDER EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING TO PLAN YEARLY PROGRAM AND PRESENT ALL PLANS AT A PATHFINDER STAFF MEETING.**
- 9. ADVERTISE THE PROGRAM AT LEAST SIX WEEKS BEFORE OPENING NIGHT AND CONTACT POTENTIAL PATHFINDER FAMILIES.**
- 10. HOLD AN ENROLLMENT NIGHT.**
- 11. HOLD AN INDUCTION CEREMONY.**
- 12. EVALUATE PROGRAM REGULARLY.**
